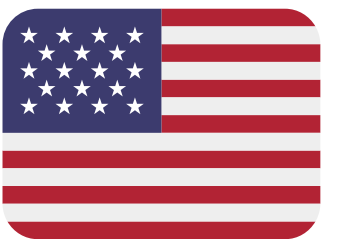

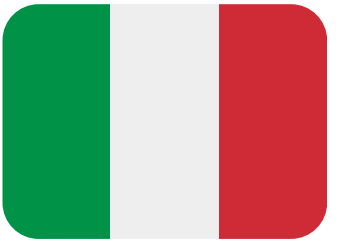
She has fellowships in Arthroscopic and reconstructive knee surgery at some of the best centers of Europe (Porto, Lyon, Barcelona and Hamburg).

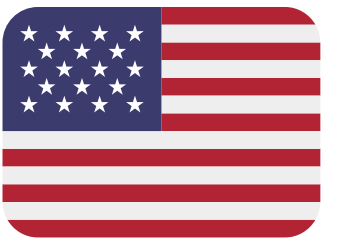


Janice Guimarães, MD, MSc

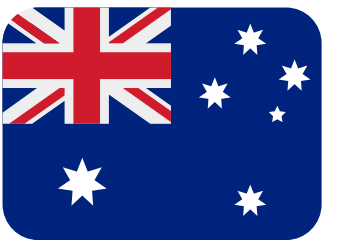


Dr. Ievgeniia Kryvoruchko
